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### Engaging 21st Century Teenagers through Student-Centred Learning (and an overview of CELT-P and CELT-S)

Do your students fall asleep in class? Why is this so? One of the reasons might be – however dreadful the word may sound to us – that they are utterly bored and not involved or challenged enough. Unlike adults, who are used to receiving information in the form of text on paper, young people are likely to use other sources. Teenagers are ‘screenagers’ who absorb a lot of information from visual stimuli. As a result, when presented with a textbook or a worksheet, they are often bored and disengaged. In this session, we will have a look at what student-centred learning is about and how to ensure our lessons keep our teenage students busy from lead-in to the feedback stages to maximize their engagement and increase their motivation.

### Frankenstein: Mary Shelley's novel and its popular heritage

Frankenstein, which celebrates the 200th anniversary of its first publication in 2018, is perhaps the first example of science fiction in English. It is certainly an early example of the gothic horror genre. It is without doubt a great 'novel of ideas'. It has also given rise to a huge popular tradition.

This session will highlight the key contents of Mary Shelley's novel, and show how subsequent adaptations (particularly James Whales's classic films *Frankenstein* and *Bride of Frankenstein*, but also Kenneth Branagh's 1994 version) differ from the source novel. We will examine the reason for and the effect of these divergences, which have given rise to a popular culture independent of the source novel, firmly rooted in the twentieth century.
